
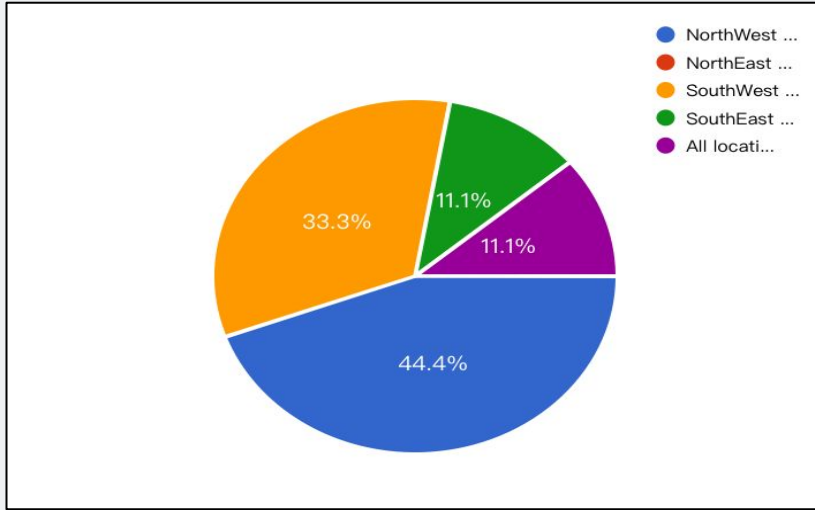


Making Santa

Case Study: Pedestrian Struck by Vehicle, killed in Santa Rosa

- Wearing bright and light colors
- More crosswalks lights



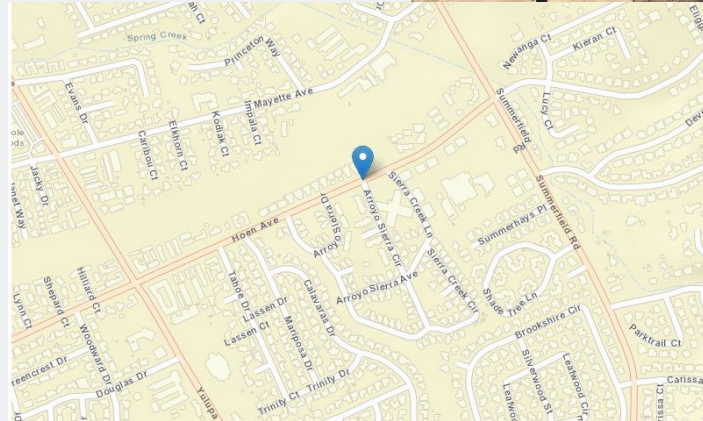
Case Studies:

Santa Rosa middle school student in critical condition after being hit by vehicle

A young pedestrian using the crosswalk was put in critical conditions due to a vehicle hitting him in broad daylight. This happened in daylight, image this accident at night with less lighting.

SOLUTIONS:

- More reflectors on road
- Reducing speeds and adapting to road conditions



Start out in small neighborhoods where there is very poor lighting

Look at the impact it has in the environment and surrounding elements



If it shows an effected change, proceed with expanding

Solar powered lights in the city

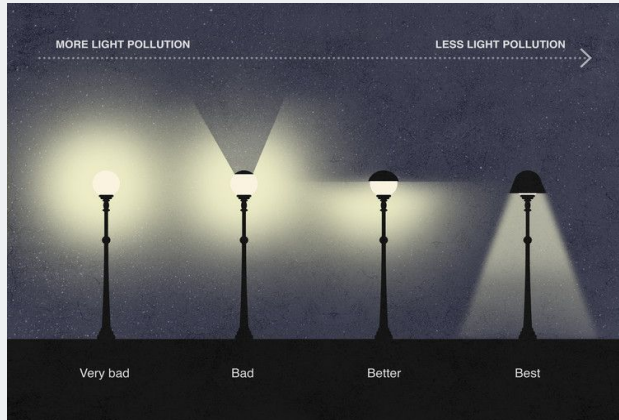
When a street light or community light fails, malfunctions, or just stops working around the city, we can replace it with the new solar power light post.
